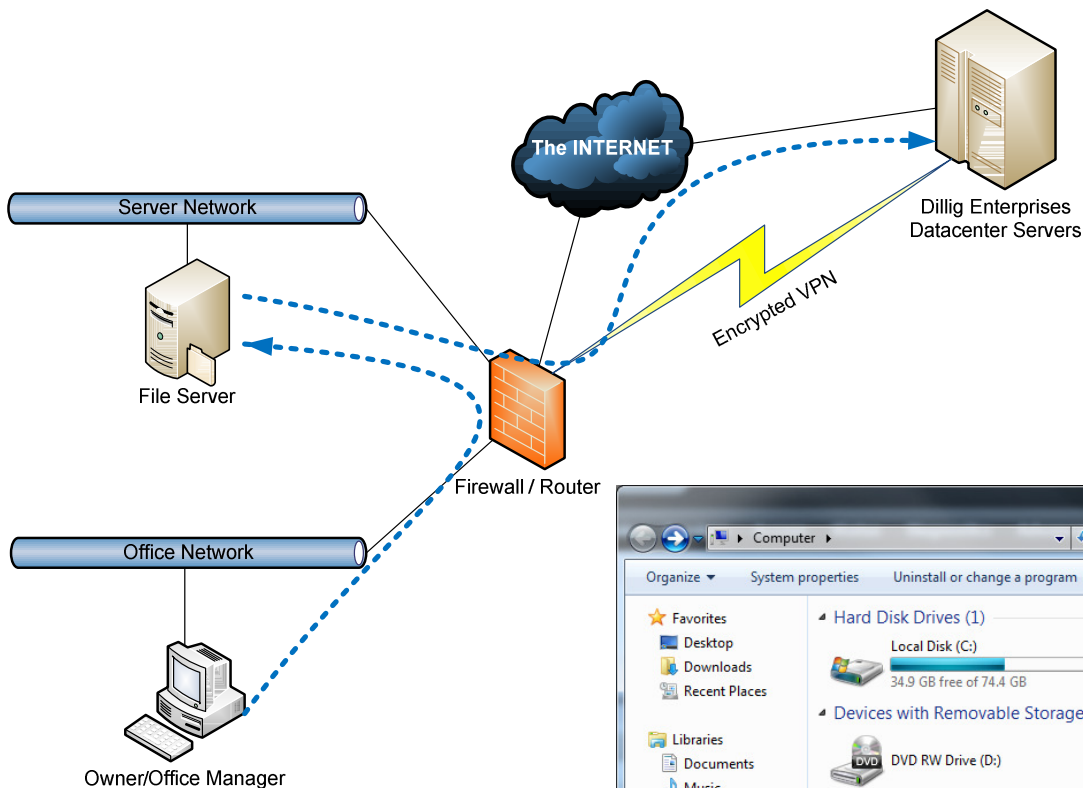

Small Business Centralized File Storage

Centralized file storage provides the ability for multiple office users to share documents very easily. Additionally, it simplifies backups and recovery. No longer does a single computer crash cause data loss. Users can simply utilize a second office computer to access files that are stored centrally. In this diagram, we show how an office users saves and access their files on the central file server and how nightly backups transfer copies of these files off-site. All of this is seamless to the users in the office. It is already best to be safe, and keep multiple backups available.



A VPN is formed between your firewall and the servers at Dillig Enterprises. This Virtual Private Network connection is encrypted and completely secure.

The network file server shows up on each desktop or laptop as a new drive just like a local hard drive. In this example, the drive letter is "Z:"
